LERH has been recently selected by the **European Commission Joint Research Centre** (JRC) for defining a **Collaborative Doctoral Partnership (CDP)**





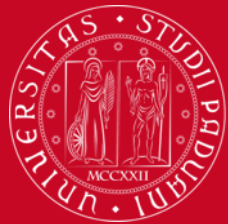


