More detailed information

1. How to reach Padova

By Plane

You can fly in one of the three airport of Veneto Region:

- [Venice](http://www.veniceairport.it/en/) (Marco Polo) www.veniceairport.it/en/
- [Treviso](http://www.trevisoairport.it/en/) (Canova) www.trevisoairport.it/en/
- [Verona](http://www.aeroporto.verona.it/en/) (Catullo) www.aeroporto.verona.it/en/

Among the three choices, Venice airport is the most linked with other land transport (busses and trains). Nonetheless, fly to Treviso or Verona is cheaper. Treviso airport holds all the regional flight operated by Ryanair.

From Venice Airport to Mestre railway station, you need to take the shuttle bus ATVO. The ticket must be purchased at bus and ferry office or next to the bus stop in the automatic machine (only cash). The cost is 8€ one way. Do not purchase the ticket in the bus: the cost more! (Timetable: www.atvo.it/it-orari-e-autolinee.html). You can reach the railway station also by taxi but the cost is around 30-40€ according to day, night time. Other useful information can be found in the airport website.

From Verona to Verona Porta Nuova station, you need to reach the train station with the airport shuttle that runs from 6.30 a.m. till 11.35 p.m. every 20 mins. You can use also taxi to reach the train station. The cost is around 20-30€. Other useful information can be found in the airport website.

From Treviso airport to Padua, you need to take a SITA bus ([Timetable h https://www.trevisoairport.it/trasporti/autobus.html](https://www.trevisoairport.it/trasporti/autobus.html)). The bus stop is located in front of the airport exit on the other side of the road.

By Train

From (all) the railway stations to Padua there are several options. The train connections are quite good and frequent but we cannot provide a unique solution for you. Anyway, you can easily check your train time schedule by your own. Please, click here or in the Trenitalia web page (<http://www.trenitalia.com/tcom-en>), and then insert your travel details (see the pictures on the left)

The search engine should turn back to you all available solutions for your transfer to Padua and the way back. NOTE! You can purchase regional train on-line only within the seven days before your trip. Unfortunately, the information are often in Italian also if you are searching in English version (see here below)!

Once you are at the train station you can purchase the tickets from the automatic ticket machine or the ticket office whether it is open. The tickets for the regional train cost 3.30€ one way (30 min - 3-5 stops) or 15.00€ with Freccie trains (15 min - one stop).

2. Climate

The climate is continental, with great extremes of temperature. Bring suitable clothing with you. During the winter months (November to February), temperatures may be as low as -5 degrees and it is sometimes foggy. Spring is sunny and often warm. Summer may be hot and humid. The average temperature range s between 0 degrees in Winter and 30 degrees in Summer.

3. Transports in Padova

Padova is quite a small town and therefore the easiest way to get around is by walking or cycling. It is very easy to buy a used bicycle.

For those who want to take advantage of the "APS Mobilità" public bus service (a ticket costs Euro 1.70 / 2.00), we suggest the monthly bus season ticket which costs about Euro 28.60 / 37.40 a month. It can be obtained from "APS Mobilità", by presenting a photo and a certificate of student status prepared by International Relations Office of our University.

4. Post offices

Post offices are usually open from 8.30 am to 2 pm (1 pm on Saturdays). The Central Post Office (Corso Garibaldi, 25) remains open until 6.30 pm (Monday to Saturday).

Stamps can be also purchased at the tobacconist's.

5. Banking

Most banks are open Monday to Friday, from 8.20 am to 1.20 pm, and from 2.35 pm to 3.35 pm. In order to open a bank account you need a fiscal code which can be obtained at:

Opening hours Monday to Friday from 8.30 to 12.30 am and Monday and Wednesday also from 3 to 5 pm.

For the code, you need to show a copy of your registration to the City Hall and a declaration of your status.
